Estimated upcoming costs: Remainder owing on the rectory: \$46,400; Father's car repairs: \$1,000; Foundation: \$4-8,000; Electrical and plumbing: \$20,000; Skirting and deck: \$5-8,000; Church insurance: \$10,000; Convent electric panel: \$3,000; Fundraiser goal: \$35,000. Fundraisers started: 1. One time second collection today. 2. Letters to family, friends and small businesses you know. Jeani will prepare letters with self-addressed and stamped return envelopes. Please email or text Jeani or Sr. Mary Catherine with lists of potential businesses, family and friends who might be willing to help. This way we don't double send. We'll meet Thursday, September 23rd, at 1:30 in the church basement to help fill out the letters. All available hands on deck. We'll also need help delivering as many as possible. Hand delivered is always more effective especially if you know the business or have patronized it for years. Encouragement for businesses who donate: they will be given a tax receipt and we will advertise in our bulletin and yearbook that these businesses helped us and encourage their patronization. 3. If you pledge, he will run. Father Augustine will run in the jogathon on October 8th. Whatever he earns will go to the rectory. Help Father gather pledges per 1/8 mile lap he makes in an hour. SEVEN GRACES OF OUR MOTHER OF SORROWS - The Blessed Virgin Mary grants seven graces to the souls who honor her daily by meditating on her tears and dolors (sorrows). The Hail Mary is prayed seven times, once after each meditation. This devotion was passed on by St. Bridget. 1. I will grant peace to their families. 2. They will be enlightened about the divine mysteries. 3. I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work. 4. I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my Divine Son or the sanctification of their souls. 5. I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives. 6. I will visibly help them at the moment of their death, they will see the face of their Mother. 7. I have obtained (this Grace) from my Divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolors will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness since all of their sins will be forgiven and my Son and I will be their eternal consolation and joy.
