Therefore I devote to Thee, Oh! sweetest, dearest Heart, every word and deed, every throb of my heart, all that I do or suffer during this year. Accept my offering, and strengthen me with Thy grace; enlighten and shield me, and grant me in virtue of Thy name, that most holy, most efficacious name of Jesus, this my request
